

# Distinguished Alumni Award Eligibility and Selection Criteria Schedule B

## **Confidentiality:**

The UFV Alumni Association Board of Directors will keep all submissions received confidential.

### **Eligibility and criteria:**

The nominee must meet the following criteria:

- Meet the definition of alumni as defined in the Alumni Association By-laws 1. (e)

   graduated with a masters degree, bachelors degree, diploma, certificate or citation from FVC, or the UCFV, or the UFV, or who prior to January 1, 2004, completed 30 or more credits.
- 2. The nominee must have reached 35 years of age before April 1, of the year in which the award is presented.
- 3. Demonstrated distinct excellence, in one or more of the following areas:
  - Community, national, and international contributions
  - Commitment to others
  - Acting with selflessness and/or courage
  - Leadership
  - Creativity/innovation
- 4. The candidate selected to receive the Distinguished Alumni Award must attend the presentation ceremony to receive the award.
  - Except in rare circumstances: posthumous award or unexpected illness or emergency
- 5. The nominee grants the UFV Alumni Association permission to validate any claims made in the nomination package.

# **Exclusions from eligibility:**

- Members of the UFV Board of Governors and UFV Senate
- Members of the UFV Alumni Association Board of Directors and UFV Alumni Relations office staff
- Active politicians

The Alumni Association reserves the right to revoke the award, should circumstances arise that unfavourably affect the reputation of the UFV Alumni Association.

## **Nomination Package**

A valid nomination package will reflect the terms of reference outlined in the **Eligibility and criteria** section above, and consist of the following:

- 1. One completed Nomination Form.
- 2. One completed Nominee Release Form signed by the nominee to:
  - Let his/her/zir name stand in nomination
  - Agree to attend the presentation ceremony if selected to receive the Distinguished Alumni Award
- 3. Minimum of two (2) letters of reference from community members.
- 4. Up to a maximum of three (3) supporting documents, submitted by the nominator. (i.e. current resume/curriculum vitae, newspaper/magazine articles, other awards or recognition).

The pool of eligible candidates shall be those who submitted their application by the closing date – **May 1.**
