



Alumni Representative on UFV Senate Information

Senate is the academic governing body at UFV that is responsible for managing academic policies and advising the Board on policies of mutual interest. It consists of 33 members, and meets monthly (Fridays from 1:30-3:30). Senate members are expected to serve on a minimum of two standing committees of the Senate.

Senate business is conducted through its standing committees. Committees in **bold** are open to faculty, only:

Alumni Representative on Senate Nomination and Selection Timeline

After the deadline of August 31, 2023 - the Alumni Board will review all nomination applications as outlined in the criteria and guidelines and will determine which candidate to nominate for the vacancy. On behalf of the Governance Committee, the Office will:

- (a) Forward the name of the selected candidate to the Senate.
- (b) Inform all candidates of the decision of the Alumni Board and ensure the successful candidate receives all relevant materials.

Should this nominated representative not meet the requirements of the position or behave in a manner contrary to the mission or goals of the Alumni Association, the Committee will advise the Alumni Board immediately, and the Alumni Board will decide on the appropriate course of action.
